Dear MCC Parents and Students,

Behind the Wheel instruction through MCC Community Education will run two separate schedules this summer. One car will be doing instruction in one week sessions with only 2 students per vehicle while the other car will be offering two week sessions with 3 students per vehicle. The one week sessions will require instruction on Saturdays as well in order to get in the full 6 hours per student. Three time slots are available for each car for each session offered. (See schedule for dates and times)

Instructors for MCC Behind the Wheel are David Johnson and Chuck Benda. Derek Lieser is finishing up his credits and will be certified early summer as well. Mr. Lieser may take over a session or two once certified. **Cost for the course is \$225.** This must be paid when you register. *Checks should be made payable to ISD 2169. (If finances are an issue a deposit of at least \$50 may be made – white card will be held until payment is made in full).*

Registration will start on Friday, May 4 beginning at 7:30 am in the Community Education Office for students who have completed the classroom Drivers Education Course. Those students who have obtained their permits **must show their permits** at the time they sign up for Behind the Wheel. Those students who, due to a late birthday, have not obtained their permits must sign up for a session that will be held at least two weeks after their birthdays. You will not be eligible to start Behind the Wheel until you have obtained your permit. Sign up is on a first come-first serve basis. There are enough sessions available to accommodate all students but if you have a certain session that you need due to conflicts, you may want to sign up early.

All sessions begin and end at the front lobby doors of MCC High School. Students are expected to arrange for transportation to and from this site. Students are required to have their permits in their possession while driving. Students who do not have their permits will not be allowed to drive. The more prepared you are . . . the better the experience!

REMINDER: Under the new Graduated Driver License Law passed January 2015, students must now submit a drivers log verifying 50 hours of supervised driving time with a parent or guardian (15 of those hours must be nighttime driving). Parents attending a Point of Impact course are issued a parent certificate of completion which can be submitted to reduce the required supervised hours to 40 hours (15 of which still need to be nighttime driving). Enclosed is a copy of the Supervised Driving Log for you to complete and submit with your white card when taking your BTW test. Behind the Wheel instruction DOES NOT count toward your hours.
